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Simulated Hair for Brows

Semi-Permanent

Simulated hair strokes, also known by a variety of names such as **embroidery**, **microstroking** or **feather touch**, is a form of **permanent makeup** that provides a means to partially or fully camouflage missing eyebrow hair with the appearance of simulated hair using fine deposits of cosmetic tattoo pigments. Over time the strokes can blur and fade and will need to be refreshed.

Touchups for semi-permanent brows should be done every 1 to 2 years. This procedure is considered semi-permanent because a much smaller amount of pigment inserted into the epidermis layer of skin compared to the solid brow which is totally filled in with a tattoo gun into the dermis layer of the skin.
